

12 Golden Safety Rules

1



Permit To Work (PTW):

Obtain the required permits prior to starting work.

2



PPE Use:

Inspect and wear the required PPE before starting your task.

3



Hazard Management:

Complete a proper hazard assessment before starting work, and update it if conditions change.

4



Fit For Duty:

Be in a fit state to perform your duties safely.

5



Electrical Safety:

Apply controls and complete testing using approved equipment.

6



Lockout/Tagout (LOTO):

Complete proper LOTO to isolate the energy source (Electrical, Mechanical, Hydraulic, Thermal, etc.).

7



Safe Driving:

Obey all driving laws.

8



Confined Space:

Have a valid entry permit, rescue plan, and supervision in place before entering a confined space.

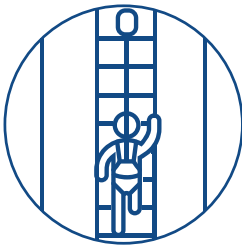
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Line of Fire:

Position yourself and others safely, away from the line of fire.

Working at Heights:

Protect yourself by strictly following all working at heights protocols.

Lifting and Rigging:

Have a lifting and rigging plan in place and clearly identify the control area before starting work.

Dropped Objects:

Secure all tools and materials before beginning elevated work.
